

Instructions For Using the Shuttle

1. Drive to the Van Norman Street Parking Lot entrance (Located across Algoma Street from the main entrance to St. Joseph's Hospital).
 2. Press button on speaker box - when answered, specify that you would like to use the shuttle parking.
 3. Parking lot arm will open, please proceed to one of the designated shuttle parking spots.
 4. Wait at the pick-up location (shuttle runs every 15 minutes).
 5. Shuttle will drop-off and pick-up at the Algoma Street entrance to St. Joseph's Hospital.
- * The driver will collect parking passes or stamp punch cards when you are picked-up to return to your vehicle.

Shuttle Service Now Available!

St. Joseph's Care Group is pleased to offer a new shuttle service at St. Joseph's Hospital for clients and visitors who require close proximity parking.

Our new shuttle service will run every 15 minutes to transport clients and visitors from our parking lot on Van Norman Street to the drop-off/pick-up location at St. Joseph's Hospital on Algoma Street.

Who can use the shuttle service?

This service is intended for individuals who need:

- Accessible parking
- Close proximity parking
- To provide assistance to people visiting or attending appointments at St. Joseph's Hospital

Do I need an accessible parking pass to use this service?

The shuttle service is intended for people who have difficulty walking from the Waterfront District Parkade. As well, this service is for companions providing assistance to someone visiting or attending an appointment.

When is the shuttle available?

The shuttle will run every 15 minutes, Monday to Friday, 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM.

What type of vehicle is the shuttle?

The shuttle is an accessible bus designed to accommodate people with physical disabilities.

Where is the parking lot?

The shuttle service picks up and drops off at the Van Norman Street parking lot located across the street from St. Joseph's Hospital

Is there a cost?

There is no cost to use the shuttle, however, there are parking fees to use the Van Norman parking lot.

Parking passes can be purchased at Central Registration Area (CRA), located beside the elevators on the main floor at St. Joseph's Hospital.

A single pass is \$5 or you can purchase a punch card with ten passes for \$40, which provides a \$10 savings.



How does the shuttle work?

People using the shuttle service will park their vehicle in the Van Norman Street parking lot. The shuttle runs every 15 minutes, please allow extra time so that you arrive on time for appointments.

When you are ready to leave, purchase a single pass or punch card at Central Registration (CRA).

Return to the pick-up/drop-off area in the hospital's Algoma Street lobby and take the shuttle back to your vehicle. The driver will collect passes prior to the return trip.
