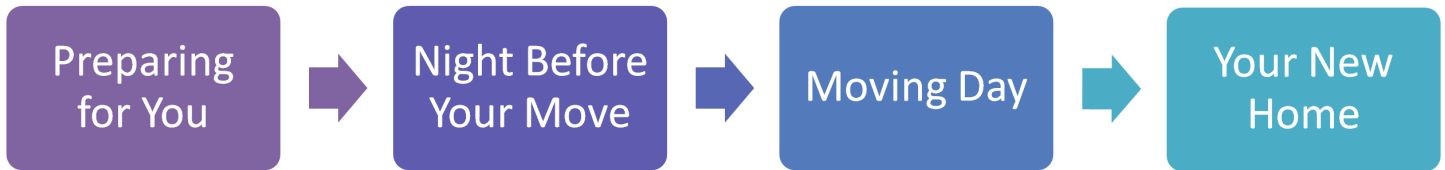

# What You Need to Know About Your Move Day

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## Preparing for You

HRM staff will be informed of all important resident information including:

- Medications
- Lab results
- Dietary information
- Pre & post risk assessment
- Important healthcare requirements i.e. Intravenous medications
- Specialty safety resources required e.g. restraints, bed alarms, fall mats,
- Health information e.g. weight, creatinine levels
- Attending Physician orders
  - Ensure necessary medications are prescribed and ordered
  - Complete other orders e.g. diet, immunization, treatments

## Night Before Your Move

- Dawson Court staff will pack discharge suitcase for residents and ensure that each resident has an appropriate coat for the weather.

## Moving Day

- Morning care routine and medications administered as usual.
- Residents will be transported to their new home via a bus
- The bus will leave their City of Thunder Bay home at 10:00 AM
- Upon arrival, resident and their family/friends assisting with the move will receive an orientation to Hogarth Riverview Manor.

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**9:30 AM**

- Residents will be transported to their new home via a bus



**10:00 AM**

- Bus leaves Dawson Court
- Residents are accompanied by a Registered Practical Nurse and Personal Support Worker as well as additional support staff.



**10:30 AM**

- Arrive at Hogarth Riverview Manor
- Welcome team of managers and directors present
- Welcome and orientation in Town Hall



**11:00 AM**

- Each resident will be paired with a staff or volunteer and brought to their room
- Staff and volunteers will ensure each resident is settled and comfortable
- If a resident would like, they can enjoy some quiet time in their room

**12:00 PM**

- Residents will have lunch together in the dining room
- Special dietary needs of residents will be provided



**1:00 PM – 5:00 PM**

- Resident assessments will begin, family members are welcome to stay and be involved.
- Unpacking of resident personal belongings by family, staff or volunteers if required
- Continued orientation of the home area and to space e.g. living room, activity rooms
- Life Enrichment activities on the resident home area
- Nourishment break at 2:15 pm



**EVENING**

- Residents will have dinner served in the dining room at 5:00 PM
- Life enrichment activities
- Evening medication and care provided
