

How it Works

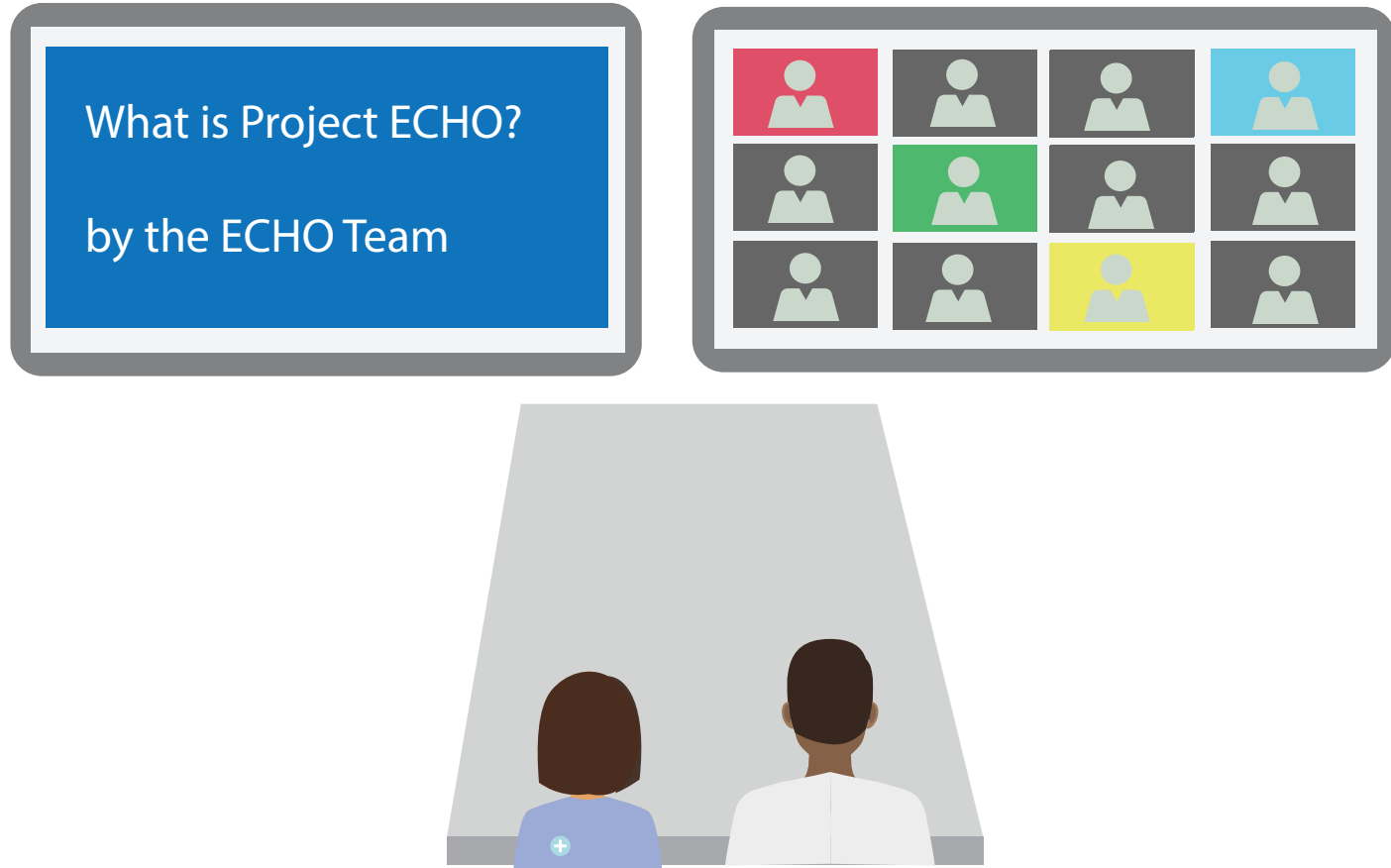
1 Healthcare providers register for ECHO Programs at no cost. Providers join ECHO sessions via videoconferencing on a regularly scheduled basis



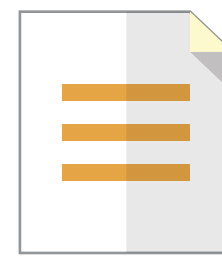
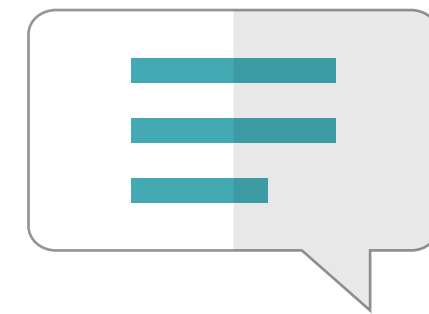

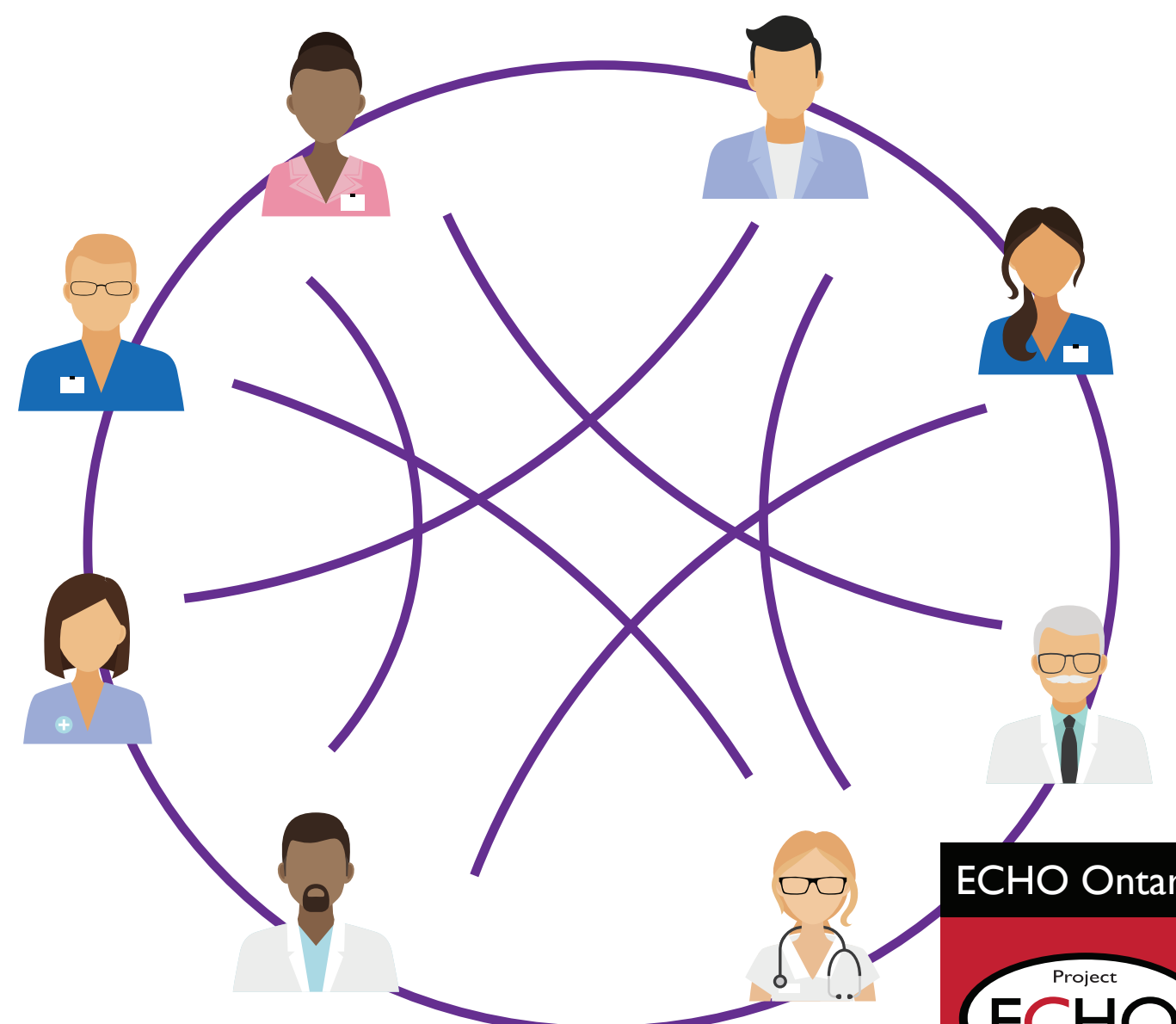


2 ECHO sessions include didactics from subject experts and cased based learning. Participants become part of a supportive community of practice connecting providers and an interprofessional team at an academic/hospital setting.



3 Participants are encouraged to present de-identified patient cases to the community, participate in discussions, and evaluation surveys. They also receive no cost CPD credits.

4 Overall, disparities in communities are reduced and health of populations increase as patients receive best practice care from their local healthcare providers.



5 Through the ECHO Model, community providers and specialists learn from each other, acquire knowledge, skills, increase competency and build a strong community of practice.
