Questions?

Do I need to complete an application?

All interested volunteers are required to complete and return an application package to Volunteer Services at Hogarth Riverview Manor.

Do I need to attend orientation?

Volunteers are required to attend a mandatory Volunteer Services orientation.

Will training be provided?

Training will be provided for all volunteers by St. Joseph's Care Group staff.

Will I require a Police Record Check?

Volunteers are required under the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007* to have a current police record check.

TB skin testing

TB skin testing is required, and will be conducted by St. Joseph's Care Group.

Do I have to wear a uniform?

All volunteers will be provided with a tshirt for identification purposes. T-shirts will be distributed at the orientation.

What level of commitment do I need to make?

A minimum commitment of three months is required to assist with this project.
