What it Means to Work in Mental Health and Addictions Services

You will work with interdisciplinary team members to provide clients with a stable and supportive environment. These environments allow for therapeutic relationships with clients in order to help

them reach their personal wellness goals.

Skills and Roles

Common skills you will commonly practice in mental health and addictions services:

- Administration and education provision of psychiatric medications
- IM injections
- Therapeutic Interviewing
- Learn about and utilize many clinical rating scales for monitoring client wellness and safety (COWS, CIWA, AIMS)
- Harm reduction
- Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (NCI)
- Develop therapeutic communication skills
- Safe restraint education and methods of least restraint.

SJCG's Mental Health and Addictions

St. Joseph's Hospital: In the new addition at St. Joseph's Hospital there are two dormitory-style floors designed to reflect a home-like environment for client's requiring mental health rehabilitation. Services specialize in providing post-acute mental health and psychosocial rehabilitation to clients with severe, persistent, chronic and/or reoccurring mental illness.

Lodge on Dawson - The Lodge on Dawson provides transitional housing for people living with addiction and mental health issues to continue their recovery by having their basic needs met, such as a safe place to live, healthy food and professional supports for skill development to live interdependently in the community.

Addiction Treatment is provided at Sister Margaret Smith Centre located at 301 Lilllie St. N. and provides outpatient and live-in treatment for addiction to substances, behavioural addictions and eating disorders.

The Sister Margaret Smith Centre location provides many outpatient treatment programs for addiction recovery, behavioural addictions and eating disorders. Live-in programs are also available for those who need intensive treatment. Live-in treatment allows the client to focus on self-discovery, their health and future. The programs runs over four weeks and includes group therapy, individual counselling, education sessions, life skills development, and introduction to self-help and leisure and recreation opportunities.

Withdrawal Management at Balmoral Centre is a 24-bed, medically-supervised withdrawal management stabilization centre. Balmoral Centre provides a safe place for people 16 years+ to withdraw/detox from substance use. We are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Services provided at Balmoral centre include: Support and care during the acute stages of intoxication,

referrals and linkages for medical, counselling, addiction treatment, harm reduction and mental health services, discharge planning in collaboration with community partners and Indigenous cultural services.

Mental Health Supportive housing - Guided by the principles and values of psychosocial rehabilitation, Supportive Housing provides community living for people who have a serious mental illness and require treatment, rehabilitation and support in completing activities of daily living including maintaining personal hygiene, nutrition and safety, managing finances, legal issues, medication and

personal health etc. In this recovery oriented program there are two types of accommodation provided, high and medium, based on level of support required.









Mental Health Outpatient Program (MHOP) - Mental Health Outpatient Program is an interprofessional, time-limited, goal-oriented team approach to mental health treatment. The program aims to provide timely access to mental health services using an evidence-based decision guide model that is focused on matching mental health needs to the appropriate service(s) available. We aim to support individuals in making better informed, strength-based and holistic choices for their mental health treatment.
