St. Joseph's Care Group (SJCG) has a wide range of placement opportunities for students looking for experience in addictions, mental health, long-term care, rehabilitation, chronic disease management and end-of-life care. We are committed to fostering a positive learning environment for students by providing appropriate support and resources throughout their placement period. As a learner, you will work as part of our healthcare team to provide safe and individualized client-centred care.

Long-Term Care Homes

SJCG operates two non-profit long-term care homes in Thunder Bay.

- Bethammi Nursing Home (BNH) – 63 Carrie St.
- Hogarth Riverview Manor (HRM) – 300 Lillie St. N.

With capacity for 544 residents, HRM is the largest long-term care home in Ontario. Demand for long-term care in our community is high with both homes operating at full capacity throughout the year. The care needs of our residents is diverse. As a student, you can expect to care for residents with complex healthcare needs that include physical and cognitive challenges. The Skills that are used in LTC are diverse based on resident care needs, and can include IV and PICC line care, Ostomy Care, Peritoneal Dialysis, Complex Wounds, and Respiratory interventions such as BIPAP and CPAP. Palliative care is imbedded into our resident-centred care.

A Behavioural Support Unit is located at HRM and is a short-term program for seniors experiencing responsive behaviours. Once their needs are addressed, residents will return home or to their long-term care home.

Supportive Housing for Seniors'

St. Joseph's Care Group operates two Supportive Housing apartments to help keep seniors living independently in their own home by assisting with daily living tasks.

- PR Cook Apartments (St. Joseph's Heritage) – 63 Carrie St.
- Sister Leila Greco Apartments – 330 Lillie St. N.

Supportive housing can delay or prevent the need to move into a long-term care home. The services provided allow tenants to live in their own residence while retaining as much independence and private life as possible. Support staff are on-site 24 hours a day/7 days a week and can provide assistance with:

- Personal care
- Meals
- Housekeeping
- Social activities
- Bathing
- Medication reminders
- Laundry
- Outings
