As a learner, you will work as part of our healthcare team to provide safe and individualized client-centred care.

Diabetes Nurse Educator

A Diabetes Nurse Educator plans, develops, implements and evaluates diabetes education services; providing education awareness, acting as a resource consultant, and providing advocacy lobbying within the Diabetes Health Program. The Diabetes Nurse Educator works as part of the interprofessional team to provide ongoing diabetes education with the goal of maximizing self-management for the client.

Chronic Pain Management

The Chronic Pain Management Program is an interprofessional, time-limited, goal-oriented, team approach to self-management of chronic pain. The program aims to enable clients with chronic pain to enhance their ability to function in all aspects of their lives. This holistic program allows you as a future nurse to facilitate the maintenance and improvement of the overall aspects of the individual's life, health and well-being.

Wound Care Nursing

The Wound Care Program provides assessment, treatment and recommendations for clients living with a wound that is a slow to heal. Students will learn about wound management that may include education, counseling, pressure reduction, compression therapy, skin conditioning, wound care recommendations and follow-up.

Ambulatory Care (Outpatient)
