Mental Health Rehabilitation

In the new addition at St. Joseph's Hospital there are two dormitory-style floors designed to reflect a home-like environment for client's requiring mental health rehabilitation. Services specialize in providing post-acute mental health and psychosocial rehabilitation to clients with severe, persistent, chronic and/or reoccurring mental illness.

Medically Complex Services

Develop critical nursing skills related to post-acute illness and chronic disease management by participating in chronic ventilator care, complex wound care, peritoneal dialysis and many other medical and post-surgical complex needs.

Rehabilitative Care Services

Provide high intensity, time-limited, interprofessional rehabilitation, with a focus on clients with musculoskeletal conditions and/or who have experienced a spinal cord injury. Develop your knowledge and experience with diagnoses including: Hip and/or knee replacement; Amputation and Prosthetic-training stage, Hip fractures, Spinal Cord Injuries and Neurological Conditions

Hospice Palliative Care

Build relationships with clients and their families as you support their walk through some of life's hardest moments providing pain/symptom management and/or facilitate end-of-life care.



Transitional Care

Support and maintain the health and wellness of clients who are awaiting alternate care placements. Assist in the bridging of these clients to appropriate services in their transition of care.

Geriatric Assessment & Rehabilitative Care

Help older adults improve their functional abilities to be able to be as independent as possible. The program offers medium intensity, time-limited interprofessional rehabilitation to adults 65 years or over who are experiencing complex health problems.
